

Even with debate about their name's origin and the exact boundaries of their $^{\land}$ community, Jacks Creek residents know their neighbors — and their barbecue.

COMMUNITY BEYOND BOUNDARIES

ALTHOUGH NO ONE KNOWS FOR SURE HOW JACKS CREEK CAME TO BE NAMED JACKS CREEK, LEGEND HAS IT CONNECTED WITH A SMALL BOY, APPARENTLY NAMED JACK, WHO WENT TO THE CREEK TO GET WATER. HE EITHER DROWNED, WAS KIDNAPPED BY INDIANS OR CAME BACK WITH SOME GOOD WATER. TAKE YOUR PICK. AT ANY RATE, THE CREEK CAME TO BE CALLED JACKS CREEK, AND THE SETTLEMENT TOOK THAT NAME AS WELL.



Boundaries of the unincorporated community are hard to define. According to unofficial mayor Patsy Nobles Jones, it begins at the post office on Hwy 100 East. Strangely, that puts the community's volunteer fire and rescue station outside Jacks Creek. So, they have rented a post office box with an appropriate address. Living in Jacks Creek may be a state of mind, so if you want to say you're from Jacks Creek, feel free to do so-and get yourself a PO box.

Jacks Creek began in the early 1820s and was a part of Henderson County until 1882, when Chester County was formed. The first business opened about 1830 and a post office as early as 1837. It was discontinued in 1866 and re-established in 1874. Open today with reduced hours, it is a meeting place. "You wouldn't believe how busy this post office is," employee Beth Hurst said. It defines the community and binds it together.

Three churches: Jacks Creek Church of Christ, Beech Springs Baptist Church and the Apostolic Church are located in the community. Unity Baptist, only a few miles from the post office but with a Luray address, has also rented one of those Jacks Creek post office boxes.


No one knows the date of the first school in Jacks Creek, but East Chester High School, which included grades one through 10, was erected at the current site of Jacks Creek Elementary School in 1917. Today, the school has kindergarten through third grade classes.

Although commerce today is sparse, Jacks Creek was once a bustling community, according to a 1982 booklet. In the 1930s, it was home to seven general stores, a cotton gin, bank, two barber shops, two blacksmith shops and two hamburger joints. The community also boasted two schools and three churches. Currently, Jacks Creek is home to a barbecue café, Hurst Hot Rods (which sells parts for hot rods, classic cars and rat rods), Robison Peach Farm and Ronnie Clay's accountant office.

Another long gone feature of Jacks Creek is the airfield located southwest of the Route 22A and Jones Road intersection. The federal government leased 133 acres for 20 years for Jacks Creek Intermediate Landing Field. On the flight path between Nashville and Memphis, it was designated an emergency landing field. During World War II, the airfield was a practice site for the Army Air Force. The lease expired in 1956, and the airfield reverted to farmland.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Jacks Creek native Hubert T. McGee designed Memphis' Pink Palace, as well as the Chester County Courthouse and FHU's Old Main.
- An early Jacks Creek schoolteacher became the governor of Mississippi.
- The Hamlett-Smith House is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.
- A day-long Civil War battle was fought in Jacks Creek.
- Parachute jumps and aerobatics accompanied the 1938 opening of the Jacks Creek landing field.







The hamlet (yes, pun intended) is famous for its barbecue. Jo Hilton, owner and pit boss of Jacks Creek BBQ, said, "Barbecue has been sold on this corner for at least 70 years." Unlike many Chester County barbecue establishments, hers does not cook whole hogs on an open pit. Instead, she cooks hams and shoulders in an electric cooker with smoking capabilities. Her hickory wood is from hammer handle scraps obtained locally. The quality of her product is evidenced by the rate at which she sells pork. "We went through 60 hams and shoulders during the week of July 4," she said. Other smoked items on the menu include chicken, ribs, bologna and wings.

Residents of Jacks Creek put the "commune" in community. A community club meets the second Thursday of each month with Ralph Mays as the president. On average, 40 or so show up for dinner and entertainment. Jones credits four women for holding the club together through the years: Kathy Mays, Joanne Jones, Alma Jones and Kay Robison. For years, the club has raised money by making and selling fried peach pies. The money goes to causes they support: the fire station, scholarships, Christmas gifts for nursing home residents, "because we've got folks who live there now," Jones says.

Jones calls herself the mayor because of a decades-long joke. Long-time postmaster Gary Rhodes started putting mail addressed to the mayor, police chief or any other city title in her box. Never one to miss out on a chance for some fun, she took the title, bought herself a license plate, a hat and a tee shirt. It's just for the fun, she says. "I kept the title and I wear the hat," she said. "We're just funning." That seems to be going around in Jacks Creek.

Henderson Mayor Bobby King said city hall was one of the first locations to experience the upgrade. "We do so much business over the Internet, and now we have the speed to do our jobs faster," he said.

Aeneas, a West-Tennessee company, began offering services to Chester Countians in 1996 with the first dial-up Internet services in the county. Aeneas became a fully diversified telephone company in 2000, offering broadband Internet and voice over the Internet. Aeneas is the first to offer Gigabit Internet in the area.

Leaders are hoping the improvements will have a positive impact on business growth. "We're trying to attract more businesses to Henderson. We believe this will be great for economic development for a small town," said King.

Henderson, a town of roughly 6,300 people, has access to Internet speeds that rival, and in some cases surpass, what is available in highly populated cities. "The investment that Aeneas has made in Henderson is huge! The Internet speed available to our business and others in downtown Henderson is faster than that found not only in other small towns but also in major cities around the country. "In fact, when I shared the Aeneas announcement on Facebook, a friend of mine who works in enterprise business applications posted, 'Woah! Time out! You mean to tell me I could get better bandwidth by moving from New York City to Henderson?' His statement sums up how big this investment is for our region," said Dawn Bramblett, co-owner of Bramblett Group, a marketing, advertising and public relations firm located in downtown Henderson.

Fiber optic networks are capable of extremely high speeds, reaching more than 1,000 Megabits (1 Gigabit) per second.

Making Henderson's public parks beautiful during any season, Henderson Park Director Dena Azevedo reaps what she sows.

RENEWED SPACES

HENDERSON PARK DIRECTOR DENA AZEVEDO TRADED IN HER DESIGNER SUITS FOR SUNSCREEN, SHORTS, HIP BOOTS AND A SUN HAT TWO YEARS AGO.

Pick any day during the week and you will find her in Henderson's Gene Record Memorial or Downtown parks giving their combined 25 acres as much loving care as she does her yard at home.

Henderson Mayor Bobby King hired Azevedo to revitalize and maintain the town's public parks. She inherited her mother's green thumb and learned to appreciate the beauty of the outdoors at an early age. It's not a coincidence that one of her first jobs was making a lawn look its best.

"When I was in middle school, one of my first jobs was mowing lawns for \$5.00. I would split that with my friend, who cut grass with me. Back then, gas was .50 cents a gallon," said Azevedo with a chuckle.

Her ability to transform and nurture any outdoor space has only grown more refined with time. "My mother kept a beautiful garden," she said. "I'm an outdoors person. To have a nice yard, it takes a lot of hard work, money and a love for the outdoors." Gene Record Memorial Park

Of course, summer is the busiest for Azevedo, as she works to keep everything neat, trimmed and watered. Her days usually begin at 6 a.m. with trimming and watering plants and flowers before peak temperatures.

"Believe it or not, there's always something to be done, something that can be trimmed," Azevedo said. Gene Record Memorial Park is home to various flowers including lilies, irises, tulips and buttercups. "The beauty of the parks really shines in the spring," she said.



She spends the majority of her time in Gene Record Memorial Park, the larger of the town's two public parks. When she started, Azevedo gave the public restrooms a facelift and raised money to purchase 11 new benches mounted in concrete with memorial placards. Modern Woodman donated 17 white Crape Myrtle trees, some of which line the park's walkway. Chester County Recycling donated multi-colored glass to fill in one of the many flower and decorative beds in the park. Azevedo received a donation from the Henderson Police Department this past spring, which helped purchase a John Deere Gator. She uses it daily to transport lawn equipment and navigate the park with ease.

The \$18,000 in donations covered beautification projects, which helped stretch the city's budget. "We wouldn't have been able to make as many improvements without the donations," Azevedo said.

The Downtown Park is full of colorful flowers, a raised planter, but less grass to mow. The park has wireless Internet access and is the venue for the monthly Arts in the Alley and other public events, which Azevedo attends to maintain the grounds.

Gene Record Memorial Park opened in May 1993 and is named for the former mayor who worked to create it. It has a soccer field, walking trails, children's play area and pavilions. Azevedo said park usage has increased since the improvements were made. A Facebook page dedicated to the park is filled with compliments from patrons who appreciate the walking trails, play area and array of colorful blooms.

Azevedo is hoping the momentum continues because she has a few ideas for the future. "I would like to see a water fountain put in and it would be nice to have an amphitheater. I think it would bring so much to the park," she said. In the meantime, she is focused on making Henderson's parks the best they can be.

"When I first started I would have to pick up trash daily, but now people are taking pride in the parks," said Azevedo. "People are very complimentary of the park. It gives us a sense of pride and lets us know all of the hard work is worth it."

CHICKASAW APPROVED STATE FUNDING PUTS LONG AWAITED IMPROVEMENTS AT CHICKASAW ON FAST TRACK.

Don't let renovation projects stop you from appreciating all Chickasaw State Park has to offer this fall. According to Ronald Elder, park manager, with the approval of additional state funds for capital projects, renovations to Chickasaw will begin later this year.

Approximately \$2.6 million will be used to improve the campgrounds and \$790,000 will be invested to reconstruct the Lake Placid bridge, which is no longer structurally sound. The project also includes remodeling eight of the park's 80-year-old cabins. The cabins will be historically accurate while maintaining modern conveniences such as central airconditioning. Elder said renovation and construction projects will be scheduled so the work does not disturb park visitors. No official start date has been determined.

Approximately 360,000 people visit Chickasaw annually and that number could increase to 400,000 with completion of the renovations. "We really want people to come out and see the general improvements of the park," Elder said. During the holiday season, thousands flock to Chickasaw for the annual driving tour to view hand-made decorations and hand-lit luminaries along the roadways and floating on Lake Placid. And of course, the kids are there to hand their wish lists to Santa. This year's event will be held Dec. 11 through Dec. 13.

Funded and managed through a cooperation among the Works Progress Administration, the Civilian Conservation Corps and the Resettlement Administration, Chickasaw State Park began in 1934. The State of Tennessee assumed management of the park in 1939. Chickasaw has 14,383 acres of timberland and 1,435 acres for recreational use.






